



## DUNBAR GOLF CLUB MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The attention of applications for Membership of Dunbar Golf Club and their proposer and seconder is drawn to Clause 10 of the Club's Constitution which states:

"Those wishing to apply for membership of the Club are required to comply with one of the following:

- a) that they be nominated by two Members of at least two years standing, both of whom should know the candidate personally. **The proposer will submit a letter in support of the application.**
- b) that where the applicant is a member of a Club outwith East Lothian, and is unable to obtain a proposer and seconder as in (a) above, the applicant will submit a letter from his current Club Secretary or Captain in support of his application.
- c) that where the applicant is not a member of a Golf Club and cannot obtain a proposer and seconder, the applicant will submit a letter stating why he wishes to join the Club and will thereafter be subject to an interview by a sub-committee of Council."

Each application must be submitted to the Secretary with a payment of £50 (Juniors £25). No payment is required with applications for Non-Playing Membership. This payment will be refunded should the application not be approved by Council. The payment will be deducted from the Entry Fee due as and when the candidate is admitted or in the absence of an Entry Fee being due, from the first year's subscription. Should an applicant refuse membership when offered, or the application be withdrawn after it is approved by Council, the payment will be forfeited.

In the event of an offer of membership being made, an Entry Fee will become payable. This Entry Fee will be such proportion of the amount of the subscription payable by Ordinary Members current at the time of election as may be decided at a General Meeting. This Entry Fee is not reimbursable under any circumstances and specifically does not guarantee membership of the Club for more than one calendar year.
